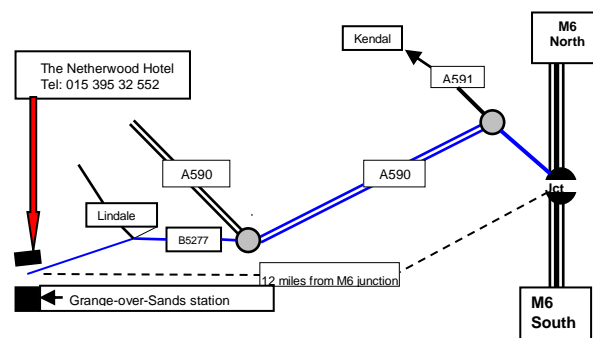
- **Where?** The Netherwood Hotel,

## SCOHSG membership

- **Who can join?**
  - Small, medium and large companies and organisations.
  - Individual membership is only available for retired SCOHSG company and organisation representatives, students and 'between jobs' safety practitioners who need to keep up-to-date with safety legislation.

- **Who can attend meetings?**
  - SCOHSG companies and organisations can send one or more representative to relevant meetings.
  - IOSH members can attend meetings free of charge because IOSH helps fund our joint meetings. IOSH membership is for individuals and does not entitle members to bring colleagues to meetings.
- **What qualifications are needed?**
  - Company and organisation representatives who attend meetings do not need a health and safety qualification.
